A former teacher, Mike taught for 16 years in New York City and Vermont. He is an expert in bullying and violence prevention, teaching best practices and realistic strategies that can be used immediately.

Some interesting statistics:

- 23% of students in grades 4-6 had been bullied "several times" or more; 20% had bullied others.
- 17% of students in grades 6-10 reported having been bullied "sometimes" or more, with 8% being bullied once a week. 19% said they had been a bully to others "sometimes" or more.
- Nearly one in five students in an average classroom is experiencing bullying in some way. The rest of the students, called bystanders, are also affected by the bullying.
